# PROGRESS REPORT OF THE CENTER FOR CLASSICAL LANGUAGE, KANNADA (2012 – 2024)

Central University of Karnataka vide its Statute 45 (Section 26 (k) of the Act), with the assent of the Visitor to the Statute vide letter No. F.42-26/2009-Desk (U) of April 19, 2011 received from the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development New Delhi, established the Centre for Classical Language-Kannada. In pursuance of this decision the Centre for Classical Language-Kannada was set up at Central University of Karnataka.

The Kannada literary tradition has a long history and strikingly contemporary relevance and it is an original tradition not borrowed from any another speech community. The classical language and literature is distinctively different from modern language and literature. There may be a discontinuity in the classical language but the later forms of language and literature are the offshoots of Kannada Classical tradition.

Rich Knowledge and Human Values can be traced in Classical Kannada, which is very useful for the young generation. Therefore, the Centre needs to address such challenges and explore the opportunities. Through a series of lectures online and offline, the Centre is trying to reach out the future generations. The classical texts have many scientific truths in their contents; they should be inculcated into modern sciences.

The Centre is established for the purpose of undertaking research on various aspects of classical Kannada Literature, Culture and it aims to train future generation of scholars for sustenance and continuity. The Centre also offers a full-time regular PhD Programme.

### The major achievements of the Centre as follows:

- 1. Contacted a number of established scholars in the field of Classical Kannada Language literature and culture to contribute their scholarly writings to the Centre.
- 2. More than ten senior writers have agreed to work on the project titled translation of Classical Kannada text into English and three scholars have already submitted their manuscripts for publications and it was duly approved by the Advisory Committee of the Centre.
